

Distinguished Student Paper Awards Manuscript Guidelines Checklist

We have created a quick checklist for you to confirm your manuscript is complete before submitting for participation in our ENAR Distinguished Student Paper Awards competition. If you do not meet these criteria, your manuscript may be disqualified.

To be considered complete:

Your submission MUST include:

- ✓ a manuscript submitted as pdf (Step 1)
- ✓ a brief abstract (1200-character count max) (Step 2)

Manuscript formatting MUST include:

- ✓ a maximum of 15 pages, inclusive of title page and tables/figures * **New for 2026!
- ✓ a maximum of 25 lines per page, double spaced
- ✓ 1-inch margins
- ✓ 12-point font
- ✓ a title page with title, brief abstract (1 paragraph in length) and keywords
- ✓ References typed using the style of the *Biometrics* journal
- ✓ Tables and figures at the end of manuscript
- ✓ no more than SIX (6) tables and/or figures

A manuscript should **NOT** include:

- **x** any identifying information in manuscript filename
- * author's names, co-author's names, and affiliations anywhere in manuscript
- * Appendices, acknowledgements and other supplemental materials.

Registration for the ENAR 2026 Spring Meeting is required as part of the abstract submission process.

^{*}References are NOT included in the 15-page limit.
