Distinguished Student Paper Awards Manuscript Guidelines Checklist

We have created a quick checklist for you to confirm your manuscript is complete before submitting for participation in our ENAR Distinguished Student Paper Awards competition. If you do not meet these criteria, your manuscript may be disqualified.

To be considered complete:

Your submission should include:

- ✓ a manuscript submitted as pdf
- ✓ a brief abstract (1200-character count max)

A manuscript should include:

- ✓ a maximum of 25 lines per page, double spaced
- ✓ 1-inch margins
- ✓ 12-point font
- ✓ a maximum of 15 pages*
- ✓ a title page with title, brief abstract (1 paragraph in length) and keywords
- ✓ References typed using the style of the *Biometrics* journal
- ✓ Tables and figures at the end of manuscript
- ✓ no more than SIX (6) tables and/or figures

**Tables and figures, the title page with the summary abstract and keywords, appendices, acknowledgements, and references are NOT included in the 15-page limit.*

A manuscript should NOT include:

- ✗ any identifying information in manuscript filename
- ✗ author's names, co-author's names, and affiliations anywhere in manuscript

**When registration opens for the ENAR 2022 Spring Meeting,
any student who plans to present, will be required to register prior to the meeting.**
